- **1. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. Sierra Nevada Hazy Little Thing IPA** – (Chico, California) Aggressively dry-hopped and less filtered because the haze is where the flavor is. 6.7% ABV – 35 IBU's.
- **3. Troegs Independent Brewing Co. Joyous IPA** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) Joyous IPA uses a bright yeast strain called Hothead Kveik that they harmonize with its vibrant tropical profile through a combination of aromatic Citra, Sabro, and Azacca hops. With soft notes of tangelo, juicy papaya, and subtle coconut, this refreshing IPA is the latest in the Hop Cycle. 6.5% ABV – IBU's not rated.
- **4. Troegs Independent Brewing Co. Grand Cacao** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) This deliciously decadent stout is built on a foundation of rich chocolate malt, caramel malt and roasted barley. Cold-steeping on Peruvian cacao nibs and natural vanilla doubles down on the smooth symphony of chocolate, and a splash of milk sugar delivers a velvety sweet and creamy finish. 6.5% ABV – IBU's not rated.
- **5. Bell's Brewery Oberon Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Oberon is a wheat ale fermented with Bell's signature house ale yeast, mixing a spicy hop character with mildly fruity aromas. The addition of wheat malt lends a smooth mouthfeel, making it a classic summer beer. 5.8% ABV – 26 IBU's.
- **6. Desperate Times Brewery Irish Red Ale** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) Moderate malt character with an initial caramel sweetness and hint of roasted dryness in the finish. 5.4% ABV – 24 IBU's.
- **7. Leinenkugel's Summer Shandy** – (Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin) A traditional Weiss beer with refreshing natural lemonade flavor that makes the perfect summer beer! 4.2% ABV – 11 IBU's.
- **8. Samuel Adams Cold Snap** – (Boston, Massachusetts) The crisp character of this lively unfiltered White Ale gets a kick from a bright blend of spring spices. Orange peel and plum add subtle sweetness, while coriander contributes a peppery bite, creating a refreshing flavor that signals spring is on its way. 5.3 % ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **9. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **10. Blue Moon Brewing Co. Belgian White** – (Denver, Colorado) A wheat beer brewed with Valencia orange peel for a subtle sweetness and bright, citrus aroma. 5.4% ABV – 9 IBU's.
- **11. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard has a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **12. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
