



Draft List:

- **1. Dogfish Head Brewery Punkin Ale** – (Milton, Delaware) A full-bodied brown ale with smooth hints of pumpkin, brown sugar, and spice! Brewed with pumpkin meat, and as the season cools this is the perfect beer to warm up with. 7.0% ABV – 28 IBU's.
- **2. Stoudts Brewing Co. Oktoberfest** – (Adamstown, Pennsylvania) This medium-bodied amber colored lager elegantly combines a touch of malty sweetness with a subtle aromatic hop character. A traditional German-style Oktoberfest, this beer is brewed with the finest imported ingredients. 4.5% ABV – 24 IBU's.
- **3. Samuel Adams Oktoberfest** – (Boston, Massachusetts) In 1810, the Oktoberfest tradition was born when Munich celebrated the Crown Prince's wedding with a special beer and 16-day party. This version blends hearty malts for a deep, smooth flavor that's perfect for the season! 5.3% ABV – 16 IBU's.
- **4. Yards Brewing Co. IPA** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) Recently updated, this American IPA features a backbone of English barley supporting a fruity, aromatic hop character with Cascade, Amarillo, Chinook, Bravo, Columbus, and Eurkea hops to create a perfectly balanced IPA. 7.0% ABV – 62 IBU's.
- **5. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **6. Rubber Soul Brewing Dropout Double IPA** (Salisbury, Maryland) A beer that takes a classic Big IPA and modifies it to epic, or rather, citric proportions. Thoroughly loaded with Citra hops and German specialty malts like Vienna and CaraFoam the roasty middle of this otherwise pungent power pale will have you screaming "Dropout!" wherever you are. 8.0% ABV – 100 IBU's.
- **7. Great Lakes Brewing Co. Eliot Ness Amber Lager** – (Cleveland, Ohio) Almost untouchably smooth-armed with lightly toasted malts and noble hops. 6.1% ABV – 27 IBU's.
- **8. Great Lakes Brewing Co. Edmund Fitzgerald Porter** – (Cleveland, Ohio) Robust and complex, this porter is a bittersweet tribute to the legendary freighter's fallen crew. Packing a flavor of rich roasted barley and bittersweet chocolate notes. 6.0% ABV – 37 IBU's.
- **9. Evil Genius Brewing Co. Purple Monkey Dishwasher Chocolate Peanut Butter Porter** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) A robust porter made with Chocolate and Peanut Butter. Beginning with a world-class American style porter recipe, which is already laden with notes of chocolate, sweet malts, caramel, and molasses, taken to the next level by infusing it with natural chocolate and peanut butter! 6.7% ABV – 35 IBU's.
- **10. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire Belgian White Ale** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) Taking inspiration from decades of experience brewing Belgian beers, Fat Tire Belgian White is made with Seville oranges and Indian coriander, both freshly ground less than a mile from the Fort Collins brewery. It's a fresh, perfectly sweet, natural tasting Belgian White. 5.2% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **11. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard sets the "standard" with a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **12. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **14. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.

- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Common Sense Citra IPA** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A smooth and drinkable double IPA bursting with citrus flavor and aroma. 8.5% ABV – 100 IBU's.
- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Peanut Butter Porter** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A peanut butter version of the Powder Horn Porter, delicious roasted peanut experience! 5.0% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **Yards Brewing Co. Rival IPA** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) A West Coast style IPA whose ingredients work in perfect harmony for a bold IPA with notes of pine and citrus. 6.2% ABV – 55 IBU's.
- **Yards Brewing Co. Thomas Jefferson's Tavern Ale** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) A historical beer in the style of a Golden Strong Ale, Tavern Ale is brewed with honey, rye and wheat just like Jefferson's own recipe. 8.0% ABV – 42 IBU's.
- **Yards Brewing Co. George Washington's Tavern Porter** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) GW's Tavern Porter is a smooth, robust ale with hints of caramel and roasted coffee flavors. 7.0% ABV – 40 IBU's.
