Jameson Irish Whiskey Caskmates Stout Edition!

A special edition whiskey that accentuates the trademark smoothness of Jameson with additional rich flavors of coffee, cocoa, and a gentle hint of hops from additional aging in stout seasoned oak barrels!

- **1. Bell's Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, this leads to a remarkably drinkable American style IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. Troegs Independent Brewing Hop Knife Harvest Ale** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) Hop Knife honors the tradition of hand harvesting hops at the peak of maturity. At the end of fermentation, the beer flows through the HopCyclone releasing a bounty of preserved citrus rind, crushed jungle and tropical aromas. 6.2% ABV–87 IBU's.
- **3. Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Red Rye'der IPA** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A Rye IPA, red in color brewed with Chinook, Cascade, and Citra hops. 7.0% ABV – 85 IBU's.
- **4. Stone Brewing Arrogant Bastard** - (Escondido, California) An award winning American Strong Ale, that touts itself in the following quote from their website: "This is an aggressive beer. You probably won't like it. It is quite doubtful that you have the taste or sophistication to be able to appreciate an ale of this quality and depth." Do you accept the challenge? 7.2% ABV - ?? IBU's.
- **5. Founders Brewing Co. Breakfast Stout** – (Grand Rapids, Michigan) The coffee lover's consummate beer. Brewed with an abundance of flaked oats, bitter and imported chocolates and a variety of coffees, this stout has an intense fresh-roasted java nose topped with a frothy, cinnamon-colored head that goes forever. 8.3% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **6. Great Lakes Brewing Co. Edmund Fitzgerald Porter** – (Cleveland, Ohio) Robust and complex, this porter is brewed in honor of the sunken freighter, with roasted barley and bittersweet chocolate-coffee notes. 6.0 % ABV – 37 IBU's.
- **7. Devil's Backbone Brewing Co. Vienna Lager** – (Roseland, Virginia) With its amber chestnut colored good looks and smooth malty finish, Vienna Lager blends color and flavor without heaviness or bitterness. Just as Vienna Lagers historically inspired Munich's Oktoberfest beers to evolve, this amber lager has evolved into an award winning beer! 5.2 % ABV – 18 IBU's.
- **8. Samuel Adams Winter Lager** – (Boston, Massachusetts) German brewers were onto something centuries ago when they created rich bock beers for the winter. This version is spiced with cinnamon, ginger, and orange peel for a deep flavor and malty finish that will warm you on a cold winter's night. 5.6% ABV – 22 IBU's.
- **9. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire Belgian White Ale** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) Taking inspiration from decades of experience brewing Belgian beers, Fat Tire Belgian White is made with Seville oranges and Indian coriander, both freshly ground less than a mile from the Fort Collins brewery. It's a fresh, perfectly sweet, natural tasting Belgian White. 5.2% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **10. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard sets the "standard" with a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **11. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **12. Smithwick's Irish Ale** – (Kilkenny, Ireland) An Irish red ale style beer from Ireland. It is a clear beer with a rich ruby color and creamy head. 4.5% ABV – 20 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **14. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.

Coming up next on draft:

- **Sierra Nevada Brewing Co. Celebration Ale** – (Chico, California) First brewed in 1981, Celebration Ale is one of the earliest examples of an American-style IPA and one of the few hop-forward holiday beers. Famous for its intense citrus and pine aromas, Celebration is bold and intense, featuring Cascade, Centennial, and Chinook hops! 6.8% ABV – 65 IBU's.
- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Golden Eagle Ale** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) Pilsner hybrid brewed as an ale, light and refreshing with Noble Czech Saaz hop character. 6.5% ABV – 55 IBU's.
