



Draft List:

- **1. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. Troegs Nugget Nectar** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) It's impossible to forget your first squeeze. Once a year, as the newest humulus lupulus harvest arrives at Troegs, they blend these super-fresh hops into an Imperial Amber Ale. Excessively dry-hopped, Nugget Nectar is an explosion of pine, resin, and mango. 7.5% ABV – 93 IBU's.
- **3. Liquid Hero Brewery Cloudification** – (York, Pennsylvania) A New England Session IPA that is light and refreshing with smooth cream-like consistency. Juicy hop forward flavor and aroma with notes of tropical fruit, citrus, orange, melon, and pear. 4.3% ABV – 35 IBU's.
- **4. Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Billy Haze IPA** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A New England Style IPA, with a juicy hop flavor and aroma featuring Mosaic, Warrior, Galaxy, and Citra Hops. 6.5% ABV – 70 IBU's.
- **5. Yards Brewing Co. Philly Pale Ale** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) Dry-hopped with an abundance of distinctive Simcoe hops, this straw colored pale ale is more drinkable than bitter, more aromatic than aggressive. This remarkably sessionable Pale Ale is crisp, hoppy, and bursting with citrus. 4.6% ABV – 37 IBU's.
- **6. Deschutes Brewery Red Chair Northwest Pale Ale** – (Bend, Oregon) The citrus punch of a big IPA, minus the one-dimensional hop sledgehammer. Several select European and domestic malts round out the edges for a complex, copper-colored brew. 6.2% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **7. Great Lakes Brewing Conway's Irish Ale** – (Cleveland, Ohio) Arrestingly smooth with a rap sheet of toasty biscuit and caramel malt flavors in this beer that pays homage to Great Lakes Brewery's owners grandfather, Pa Conway, a policeman who'd likely uphold that an Irish Ale with full-bodied caramel malt flavors is just the ticket! 6.3% ABV – 25 IBU's.
- **8. Yards Brewing Co. George Washington's Tavern Porter** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) GW's Tavern Porter is a smooth, robust ale with hints of caramel and roasted coffee flavors. 7.0% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **9. Samuel Adams Cold Snap** – (Boston, Massachusetts) The crisp character of this lively unfiltered White Ale gets a kick from a bright blend of spring spices. Orange peel and plum add subtle sweetness, while coriander contributes a peppery bite, creating a refreshing flavor that signals spring is on its way. 5.3 % ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **10. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire Belgian White Ale** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) Taking inspiration from decades of experience brewing Belgian beers, Fat Tire Belgian White is made with Seville oranges and Indian coriander, both freshly ground less than a mile from the Fort Collins brewery. It's a fresh, perfectly sweet, natural tasting Belgian White. 5.2% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **11. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard sets the "standard" with a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **12. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **14. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.

Coming up next on draft:

- **Liquid Hero Brewery Irregardless IPA** – (York, Pennsylvania) Medium bodied west coast style IPA hopped primarily with Citra hops. Pale to copper in color, this IPA packs big citrus, mango, tropical, and floral notes. 6.5% ABV – 75 IBU's.
- **Liquid Hero Brewery Rye Oatmeal Stout** – (York, Pennsylvania) Sweet, rich, coffee like dark malt flavor combined with a creamy spicy-slick consistency from additions of Oat and Rye. Tan colored head. 5.9% ABV – 27 IBU's.
- **Troegs First Cut Mango IPA** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) Each spring, hop growers dust off their pruning shears and trim the first shoots, bolstering the vines for a rich growing season. First Cut – a mouthful of silky Simcoe and a touch of mango – is a nod to this ritual, without which the world would be a less hoppy place! 6.2% ABV – 45 IBU's.
- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Old Graveyard Espresso Stout** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A very smooth American stout with an added kick of espresso that is mashed at higher temperatures with flaked barley to provide a fuller body and mouthfeel. 2 row barley provides the malt base while Aromatic and Chocolate malt imparts notes similar to coffee and unsweetened chocolate. A special roasted espresso gives this beer a boost! The equivalent of 1 shot of espresso per draft! 6.0% ABV – 48 IBU's.
