



### *Draft List:*

- **1. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. Rubber Soul Brewing Co. Paceline Session IPA** – (Salisbury, Maryland) The term "catching a draft" gets a whole new meaning with this citrusy session swiller. Like a smooth moving line of riders this session IPA sets the pace to get you where you're going. 4.3% ABV – 50 IBU's.
- **3. Troegs First Cut Mango IPA** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) Each spring, hop growers trim the first shoots, bolstering the vines for a rich growing season. First Cut – a mouthful of silky Simcoe and a touch of mango – is a nod to this ritual, without which the world would be a less hoppy place! 6.2% ABV – 45 IBU's.
- **4. Victory Brewing Co. DirtWolf Double IPA** – (Downingtown, Pennsylvania) Loaded with Mosaic, Citra, and Chinook hops, this aggressively hopped double IPA delivers an intense aroma and citrusy, earthy flavors. Full bodied with hop bitterness and resinous hop flavor. Leaves a lasting impression. 8.7% ABV – 80 IBU's.
- **5. Yards Brewing Co. Philly Pale Ale** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) Dry-hopped with an abundance of distinctive Simcoe hops, this straw colored pale ale is more drinkable than bitter, more aromatic than aggressive. This remarkably sessionable Pale Ale is crisp, hoppy, and bursting with citrus. 4.6% ABV – 37 IBU's.
- **6. Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Patriot Pale Ale** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A mixture of all American hop varieties creates a delicious blend of medium hop bitterness, hop flavor, and that wonderful hop aroma. Using 2 row barley as well as Aromatic and Crystal malts provide beer with a malty backbone that balances nicely with the hop profile. 4.5% ABV – 30 IBU's.
- **7. Devil's Backbone Brewing Co. Vienna Lager** – (Roseland, Virginia) With its amber chestnut colored good looks and smooth malty finish, Vienna Lager blends color and flavor without heaviness or bitterness. Just as Vienna Lagers historically inspired Munich's Oktoberfest beers to evolve, this amber lager has evolved into an award winning beer! 5.2 % ABV – 18 IBU's.
- **8. Liquid Hero Brewery Rye Oatmeal Stout** – (York, Pennsylvania) Sweet, rich, coffee like dark malt flavor combined with a creamy spicy-slick consistency from additions of Oat and Rye. 5.9% ABV – 27 IBU's.
- **9. Samuel Adams Cold Snap** – (Boston, Massachusetts) The crisp character of this lively unfiltered White Ale gets a kick from a bright blend of spring spices. Orange peel and plum add subtle sweetness, while coriander contributes a peppery bite, creating a refreshing flavor that signals spring is on its way. 5.3 % ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **10. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire Belgian White Ale** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) Taking inspiration from decades of experience brewing Belgian beers, Fat Tire Belgian White is made with Seville oranges and Indian coriander, both freshly ground less than a mile from the Fort Collins brewery. It's a fresh, perfectly sweet, natural tasting Belgian White. 5.2% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **11. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard sets the "standard" with a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **12. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **14. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.

- **SweetWater Brewing Co. TripleTail Tropical IPA** – (Atlanta, Georgia) A tropical approach to the IPA style – TripleTail weaves juicy and bodacious hops with notes of papaya, pineapple, and passionfruit into this lush hop forward IPA, creating a mouthwatering vacation for your senses. 5.5% ABV – 57 IBU's.
- **Deschutes Black Butte Porter** – (Bend, Oregon) Deschutes flagship beer, this beer features a rich, creamy mouthfeel which complements a layered depth revealing a distinctive chocolate and coffee notes. As the No.1 selling craft porter in the country, Black Butte is full of flavor, yet easy to drink! 5.2% ABV.
