



Draft List:

- **1. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire Amber Ale** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) This American Craft Beer Icon blends a fine malt presence, fresh herbal hop balance and a touch of fruity yeast to offer drinkers everywhere a timeless craft beer experience with a rare blend of balance and complexity. 5.2% ABV – 22 IBU's.
- **2. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire Belgian White Ale** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) Taking inspiration from decades of experience brewing Belgian beers, Fat Tire Belgian White is made with Seville oranges and Indian coriander, both freshly ground less than a mile from the Fort Collins brewery. It's a fresh, perfectly sweet, natural tasting Belgian White. 5.2% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **3. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **4. Bell's Brewery Oberon Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) An American Wheat Ale brewed with Saaz hops. A refreshing mix of malted wheat flavor and fruity notes, Oberon is the color and scent of a sunny afternoon. 5.8% ABV – 56 IBU's.
- **5. Troegs Independent Brewing Crimson Pistil Hibiscus IPA** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) It's summertime. Hop bines are growing up to 6 inches a day. Hibiscus is in full bloom. And in Crimson Pistil, the two get in a glorious tangle of berry-like tartness, sunset technicolor and sticky tropical notes. 6.2% ABV – 52 IBU's.
- **6. Rubber Soul Brewing Co. Paceline Session IPA** – (Salisbury, Maryland) The term "catching a draft" gets a whole new meaning with this citrusy session swiller. Like a smooth moving line of riders this session IPA sets the pace to get you where you're going. 4.3% ABV – 50 IBU's.
- **7. Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Minuteman Brown Ale** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A sessionable English Brown Ale, light bodied with a roasted, malty finish. 4.5% ABV – 15 IBU's.
- **8. Leinenkugel's Summer Shandy** – (Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin) A traditional Weiss beer with refreshing natural lemonade flavor that makes it the perfect summer beer. As they like to say, it's fresh squeezed Wisconsin-brewed beer. 4.2% ABV – 11 IBU's.
- **9. Founder's Brewing Co. Solid Gold Lager** – A beautifully crisp, clean lager. There's a touch of lemony citrus aroma that fills the glass and lingers in the smooth, grainy finish. (Grand Rapids, Michigan) 4.4% ABV - 20 IBU's.
- **10. Samuel Adams Summer Ale** – (Boston, Massachusetts) Crisp and tangy with refreshing lemon peel and a hint of pepper from rare Grains of Paradise. Golden, hazy, and thirst quenching, this American wheat ale balances bright citrus, Noble hops and spice for a lively brew that's perfect on any summer day. 5.3% ABV – 7 IBU's.
- **11. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard sets the "standard" with a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **12. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **14. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.

Coming up next on draft:

- **Rubber Soul Brewing Co. High Wheel IPA** – (Salisbury, Maryland) Two-row Cara Amber and Cara Foam round out this earthy IPA. But the Centennial hops really put this floral brew over the top with flavor. Like the famous Penny Farthing and other high wheel bikes, this beer will turn heads. 6.5% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **Rubber Soul Brewing Co. Urban Style Honey Ale** – (Salisbury, Maryland) Orange Blossom Honey sets the stage for this flavorful player. Malts like Honey, Cara Amber and Cara Foam round out this full bodied nectar. Dry hopped with just a touch of Cascade and you have the perfect sweet treat. 8.0% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **Great Lakes Brewing Co. Edmund Fitzgerald Porter** – (Cleveland, Ohio) Robust and complex, with rich roasted barley and bittersweet chocolate-coffee notes. 6.0% ABV – 37 IBU's.
- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Powder Horn Porter** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A brown porter with a medium body and a drinkable ABV. 2 row barley malt provides the base of this beer while generous amounts of Chocolate malt give it a dark brown, nearly black appearance. 5.0% ABV – 37 IBU's.
