Jameson Irish Whiskey Caskmates Stout Edition!

A special edition whiskey that accentuates the trademark smoothness of Jameson with additional rich flavors of coffee, cocoa, and a gentle hint of hops from additional aging in stout seasoned oak barrels!

- **1. Starr Hill Brewery Northern Lights IPA** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) A classic American-style India Pale Ale, characterized by full-flavored bitterness and citrus-floral aroma. A perfect blend of barley and hops makes this a very balanced IPA. 6.2% ABV – 55 IBU's.
- **2. Starr Hill Brewery Reviver Red IPA** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) A ruby red India pale ale brewed with American hops for a refreshing citrus aroma and flavor balanced by a firm maltiness. 6.2% ABV – 45 IBU's.
- **3. Starr Hill Brewery Orange King of Hop Imperial IPA** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) Orange King of Hop Imperial India pale ale is dry-hopped with glorious amounts of American hops and real orange zest to achieve an invigoratingly fresh aroma, which highlights the majestic citrus characteristics of the hops. 7.5% ABV – 50 IBU's.
- **4. Bell's Oberon** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) An American Wheat Ale brewed with Saaz hops. A refreshing mix of malted wheat flavor and fruity notes, Oberon is the color and scent of a sunny afternoon. 5.8% ABV – 56 IBU's.
- **5. Leinenkugel's Summer Shandy** – (Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin) A traditional Weiss beer with refreshing natural lemonade flavor that makes it the perfect summer beer. As they like to say, it's fresh squeezed Wisconsin-brewed beer. 4.2% ABV – 11 IBU's.
- **6. Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Peanut Butter Porter** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A Peanut Butter version of the Powder Horn Porter, with delicious roasted peanut butter flavor added to this medium bodied brown porter. 5.0% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **7. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) A clear, amber ale featuring a toasty malt, gentle sweetness, and a flash of hop bitterness. The malt and hops are perfectly balanced that finish clean on your palate. 5.2% ABV – 22 IBU's.
- **8. Samuel Adams Summer Ale** – (Boston, Massachusetts) Crisp and tangy with refreshing lemon peel and a hint of pepper from rare Grains of Paradise. Golden, hazy, and thirst quenching, this American wheat ale balances bright citrus, Noble hops and spice for a lively brew that's perfect on any summer day. 5.3% ABV – 7 IBU's.
- **9. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard sets the "standard" with a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **10. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **11. Smithwick's Irish Ale** – (Kilkenny, Ireland) An Irish red ale style beer from Ireland. It is a clear beer with a rich ruby color and creamy head. 4.5% ABV – 20 IBU's.
- **12. Blue Moon Belgian White** – (Golden, Colorado) The flavor starts crisps and tangy and ends with a coriander and orange spiciness. The Valencia orange peel gives a subtle sweetness to the beer. 5.4% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **14. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.

Coming up next on draft:

- **Starr Hill Brewery Grateful Pale Ale** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) A fresh spin on the American Pale Ale tradition. This extremely sessionable brew has a strong citrusy hop aroma that leads into a light body with subtle malt flavor. 4.7% ABV -26 IBU's.
- **Starr Hill Brewery Hop Buzz Coffee IPA** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) With citrus and floral coffee notes on the nose and firm hop flavor on the tongue, this is a unique take on a classic American-style India pale ale. A blend of whole Ethiopian and Honduran coffee beans comprise the dry-hop, while a soft coffee flavor percolates throughout. 7.0% ABV – 55 IBU's.
- **Starr Hill Brewery New England IPA** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) The intense haziness of this beer is attributed to the massive amount of hops added during the whirlpool and dry hop. With six different hops and two additional hop products, the blend is designed to focus on tropical citrus flavors, while allowing for the right amount of settling time to create a nice hop haze. 6.5% ABV – 35 IBU's.
- **Starr Hill Brewery Rye IPA** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) The malt bill plays host to 15% rye with honey malt for a subtly sweet accent. Tropical Calypso hops complement and bolster the spiciness of rye, allowing the grain to shine. 6.8% ABV – 50 IBU's.
- **Starr Hill Brewery Hopfetti Triple IPA** – (Charlottesville, Virginia) Featuring five different hops, including Amarillo, Apollo, Centennial, Mosaic, and Sorachi Ace, this bold yet balanced Triple IPA is sure to please! 9.0% ABV – 72 IBU's.
- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Redcoat ESB** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) Don't let the term ESB fool you, the bitter in its name is a bit misleading. Bitters are produced much more extensively in England than they are in the States, and the term across the pond carries a bit of a different meaning. Far less bitter than an IPA, its bitterness is in the same neighborhood as a pale ale. 5.5% ABV – 45 IBU's.
- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Common Sense Citra IPA** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A smooth and drinkable double IPA bursting with citrus flavor and aroma. 8.5% ABV – 100 IBU's.
