



Draft List:

- **1. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. Troegs Independent Brewing Co. First Cut Mango IPA** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) Each spring, hop growers dust off their pruning shears and trim the first shoots, bolstering the vines for a rich growing season. First Cut – a mouthful of silky Simcoe and a touch of mango – is a nod to this ritual, without which the world would be a less hoppy place! 6.2% ABV – 45 IBU's.
- **3. Victory Summer Love** – (Downingtown, Pennsylvania) With the sublime, earthy familiarity of noble European hops backed up by fresh, clean German malts, Summer Love Ale ends with a surprising burst of lemony refreshment from fistfuls of American whole flower hops. Love Summer, now! 5.2% ABV – 25 IBU's.
- **4. Leinenkugel's Summer Shandy** – (Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin) A traditional Weiss beer with refreshing natural lemonade flavor that makes it the perfect summer beer. As they like to say, it's fresh squeezed Wisconsin-brewed beer. 4.2% ABV – 11 IBU's.
- **5. Boneshire Brew Works Derry St. Wheat** – (Harrisburg, Pennsylvania) An American style Hefeweizen featuring an unfruited base for a smooth finish. 5.8% ABV - 15 IBU's.
- **6. Fat Head's Brewery Bumble Berry Honey Blueberry Ale** – (Middleburg Heights, Ohio) Brewed with fresh harvested spring honey and infused with fresh blueberries. A light, refreshing ale with a nice blueberry aroma, crackery malt flavors, a hint of sweetness and a refreshing blueberry finish. 5.3% ABV – 13 IBU's.
- **7. Yards Brewing Co. Brawler** – (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) Crafted in the style of an English mild, this malt-forward ale is great when you want to go a few rounds. Its smooth character, hints of caramel and toast and remarkable drinkability define this ruby-colored brew as a knockout session ale. 4.2% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **8. Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Powder Horn Porter** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A brown porter with a medium body and low ABV for drinkability. 2 row barley malt provides the base of this beer while generous amounts of chocolate malt give it a dark brown, nearly black appearance. 5.0% ABV – 41 IBU's.
- **9. Founder's Brewing Co. Breakfast Stout** – (Grand Rapids, Michigan) The coffee lover's consummate beer. Brewed with an abundance of flaked oats, bitter and imported chocolates, and two types of coffee, this stout has an intense fresh-roasted java nose topped with a frothy, cinnamon-colored head that goes forever. 8.3% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **10. New Belgium Brewing Co. Fat Tire Belgian White Ale** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) Taking inspiration from decades of experience brewing Belgian beers, Fat Tire Belgian White is made with Seville oranges and Indian coriander, both freshly ground less than a mile from the Fort Collins brewery. It's a fresh, perfectly sweet, natural tasting Belgian White. 5.2% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **11. Samuel Adams Summer Ale** – (Boston, Massachusetts) Crisp and tangy with refreshing lemon peel and a hint of pepper from rare Grains of Paradise. Golden, hazy, and thirst quenching, this American wheat ale balances bright citrus, Noble hops and spice for a lively brew that's perfect on any summer day. 5.3% ABV – 7 IBU's.
- **12. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard has a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **13. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **14. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
