Jameson Irish Whiskey Caskmates Stout Edition!

A special edition whiskey that accentuates the trademark smoothness of Jameson with additional rich flavors of coffee, cocoa, and a gentle hint of hops from additional aging in stout seasoned oak barrels!

- **1. Bell's Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, Michigan) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, this leads to a remarkably drinkable American style IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. Oskar Blues Dale's Pale Ale** – (Longmont, Colorado) An American Strong Pale Ale, Dale's Pale Ale is brewed with hefty amounts of European malts and four kinds of American hops, it delivers a blast of hop aromas, a rich middle of malt and hops, and a thrilling finish. 6.5% ABV - 65 IBU's.
- **3. Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Common Sense Double IPA** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) A smooth and drinkable double IPA brewed with all Citra hops. 8.5% ABV – 100 IBU's.
- **4. Troegs Independent Brewing Hop Knife Harvest Ale** – (Hershey, Pennsylvania) Hop Knife honors the tradition of hand harvesting hops at the peak of maturity. At the end of fermentation, the beer flows through the HopCyclone releasing a bounty of preserved citrus rind, crushed jungle and tropical aromas. 6.2% ABV–87 IBU's.
- **5. Leinenkugel's Summer Shandy** – (Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin) A traditional Weiss beer with refreshing natural lemonade flavor that makes it the perfect summer beer. As they like to say, it's fresh squeezed Wisconsin-brewed beer. 4.2% ABV – 11 IBU's.
- **6. Victory Brewing Co Festbier** – (Dowington, Pennsylvania) An Oktoberfest style Amber Lager, the flavor is subtly sweet with a delicate malt nose. The impressive body of the bier gains from the use of all imported German malts and decoction brewing process. 5.6% ABV – 20 IBU's.
- **7. Founders Brewing Co. Sumatra Mountain Brown** – (Grand Rapids, Michigan) This bold, imperial brown ale gets its body from a team of malts including Caramel malt for sweetness, flaked barley for dense foam, a bit of chocolate malt for its deep color and Aromatic and Munich malts to add even more depth. German and Perle hops add a touch of bitterness to balance the malty sweetness. The addition of rich Sumatra coffee takes this perfectly balanced imperial brown ale to a decadent level. 9.0% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **8. Samuel Adams Summer Ale** – (Boston, Massachusetts) Crisp and tangy with refreshing lemon peel and a hint of pepper from rare Grains of Paradise. Golden, hazy, and thirst quenching, this American wheat ale balances bright citrus, Noble hops and spice for a lively brew that's perfect on any summer day. 5.3% ABV – 7 IBU's.
- **9. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, Pennsylvania) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Big Hill Standard sets the "standard" with a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **10. Blue Moon Belgian White** – (Golden, Colorado) The flavor starts crisps and tangy and ends with a coriander and orange spiciness. The Valencia orange peel gives a subtle sweetness to the beer. 5.4% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **11. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **12. Smithwick's Irish Ale** – (Kilkenny, Ireland) An Irish red ale style beer from Ireland. It is a clear beer with a rich ruby color and creamy head. 4.5% ABV – 20 IBU's.
- **13. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, Wisconsin) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **14. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, Pennsylvania) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.

- **New Belgium Brewing Co Voodoo Ranger Imperial IPA** – (Fort Collins, Colorado) A rare blend of choice hops creates an explosion of fresh-cut pine and citrus flavors for a complex, rich and delicious flavor. 9.0% ABV – 70 IBU's.
- **Molly Pitcher Brewing Co. Black Currant Wheat** – (Carlisle, Pennsylvania) Refreshing Summer wheat beer with Black Currant fruit. 4% ABV – 23 IBU's.
