

Draft List:

- **1. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, MI) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. New Trail Brewing Co. Broken Heels Hazy IPA** – (Williamsport, PA) A hazy IPA hopped intrepidly with hand selected Citra, Mosaic, and Ekuanot leading to high aromatics of luminous Citrus, rich Conifer, and refreshing Tropicals. 7.0 % ABV – IBU's N/A.
- **3. Sierra Nevada Celebration Ale** – (Chico, CA) Hand selecting the best of Cascade and Centennial hops is the basis for this annual Christmas IPA! Citrus, pine, and floral notes highlight the flavor profile of this perfect winter beer. 6.8% ABV – 65 IBU's
- **4. Troegs Independent Brewing Co. Blizzard of Hops Winter IPA** – (Hershey, PA) Troegs created this Winter IPA to toast hop growers around the world for another successful harvest. This storm of hoppy citrus and pine notes is a bright reminder that the end of the Hop Cycle is only the beginning. 6.4% ABV – 80 IBU's.
- **5. Troegs Independent Brewing Co. Nugget Nectar** – (Hershey, PA) Once a year, as the newest humulus lupulus harvest arrives at Troegs, they blend these super-fresh hops into an Imperial Amber Ale. Excessively dry-hopped, Nugget Nectar is an explosion of pine, resin, and mango. 7.5% ABV – 93 IBU's.
- **6. Troegs Independent Brewing Mad Elf Ale** – (Hershey, PA) We welcome back the Mad Elf and its blend of sweet and tart cherries, Pennsylvania honey, chocolate malt and a hint of mischief. This legendary holiday ale is born from five varieties of tree-ripened cherries. Local wildflower honey sweetens the celebration, and a spicy Belgian yeast adds subtle notes of cinnamon, clove and allspice. 11% ABV – IBU's N/A.
- **7. Samuel Adams Cold Snap** – (Boston, MA) The crisp character of this unfiltered White Ale gets a kick from a bright blend of spring spices. Orange peel and plum add subtle sweetness, while coriander contributes a peppery bite, creating a refreshing flavor that signals spring is on its way. 5.3 % ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **8. Back Porch Brewing Sunrise Oatmeal Stout** – (Carlisle, PA) This oatmeal stout features a great blend of German and US malts. Brewed with oats and golding hops its sure to please! 5.4% ABV – IBU's N/A.
- **9. Desperate Times Turtle Stout** – (Carlisle, PA) An Imperial stout with roasted pecans, caramel, and chocolate notes similar to a Turtle candy 8.3% ABV – 75 IBU's.
- **10. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **11. Golden Road Brewing Mango Cart** – (Los Angeles, CA) A light Wheat Ale bursting with lots of fresh mango flavor and aroma, finishing crisp and refreshing. 4.0% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **12. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, PA) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Standard has a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **13. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, PA) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **14. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, WI) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.

Coming up next on draft:

- **Rusty Rail Brewing Co. Fog Monster NEIPA** – (Mifflinburg, PA) A New England Style IPA, Fog Monster has a hazy gold appearance with juicy fruit and pronounced hop characteristics from the Simcoe, Azacca, El Dorado, Citra, Mosaic, and Amarillo hops, then ends with a mild bitter finish. 6.8% ABV - 68 IBU's.
- **Great Lakes Brewing Co. Conway's Irish Ale** – (Cleveland, OH) An Irish Ale named for the brewery owners grandfather and policeman Pa Conway! Full-bodied caramel malt flavors with an arrestingly smooth finish. 6.3% ABV – 25 IBU's.
