- **1. Bell's Brewery Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, MI) Defined by its intense hop aroma and malt balance, hopped exclusively with the Centennial hop varietal from the Pacific Northwest lend their characteristic grapefruit and pine resin aromas. A significant malt body balances this hop presence; together with the signature fruity aromas of Bell's house yeast, leading to a remarkably drinkable IPA. 7.0% ABV – 60 IBU's.
- **2. Bell's Brewery Double Two Hearted Ale** – (Kalamazoo, MI) Everything you love about the classic Two Hearted Ale, now in a double IPA. With two and a half times the amount of Centennial hops, Double Two Hearted has intense pine and citrus notes, a resinous hop aroma and rich malt character. 11% ABV – IBU's not rated.
- **3. Ever Grain Brewing Joose Juicy IPA** – (Camp Hill, PA) Mid Atlantic take on a New England style IPA. A strong malty back bone supporting a hop character of dank and resinous hops; very piney and citrusy. 6.0% ABV – IBU's not rated
- **4. Troegs Independent Brewing Co. Lucky Holler Hazy IPA** – (Hershey, PA) For this soft and juicy hazy IPA the brewers at Troegs explore the intersection of Simcoe, Citra, and the Australian hop Galaxy. Dry-hopping early in the fermentation unearths aromatic notes of passionfruit, grapefruit, and bubblegum. 6.8% ABV – IBU's not rated
- **5. GearHouse Brewing Co. Ninja Boots IPA** – (Chambersburg, PA) A New England style IPA brewed with a hefty grain bill of oats, barley, and crystal malts, with no bittering hops added at boil, and almost 5#/BBL of Mosaic, Idaho-7, and Vic Secret added in both whirlpool and as a dry-hop!! 7.25% ABV – 30 IBU's.
- **6. Desperate Times Oktoberfest** – (Carlisle, PA) This traditional Marzen style Oktoberfest is a malty rich lager that starts slightly sweet and finishes dry. 5.4% ABV – 23 IBU's.
- **7. Troegs Independent Brewing Co. Master of Pumpkins Ale** – (Hershey, PA) It takes a long time to plant, raise, pick, slice, clean and roast 3,000 lbs. of local PA pumpkins. But come fall, Master of Pumpkins takes shape. Naturally fermented and subtly spiced with cinnamon, clove, ginger, and nutmeg, this is a pumpkin beer that's worth the wait. 7.5% ABV – IBU's not rated.
- **8. Sierra Nevada Oktoberfest** – (Chico, CA) This rich Marzen lager features German malts for inviting aromas of honey and biscuity bread, flavors of caramel and graham cracker. 5.5% ABV – 19 IBU's.
- **9. Back Porch Brewing Peanut Butter Hefe** – (Carlisle, PA) A traditional Hefeweizen blending German Pilsner and wheat malts with Hefeweizen yeast and Peanut Butter! 5.4% ABV – IBU's not rated.
- **10. Guinness Draught** – (Dublin, Ireland) Swirling clouds tumble as the storm begins to calm, settle, breathe in the moment, then break through the smooth, light head to the bittersweet reward. 4.2% ABV – 40 IBU's.
- **11. Golden Road Brewing Mango Cart** – (Los Angeles, CA) A light Wheat Ale bursting with lots of fresh mango flavor and aroma, finishing crisp and refreshing. 4.0% ABV – 10 IBU's.
- **12. Big Hill Ciderworks Standard Hard Cider** – (Gardners, PA) Located just miles from here, and using the finest apples, Standard has a bright, fruit-forward flavor profile. No added sugars or flavors, just carefully selected apple varieties that are grown, pressed, and fermented on the Big Hill. 5.5% ABV – 5 IBU's.
- **13. Yuengling Lager** – (Pottsville, PA) A rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness and a combination of cluster and cascade hops. 4.4% ABV – 12 IBU's.
- **14. Miller Lite** – (Milwaukee, WI) Miller Lite is the great tasting, less filling beer that created the American light beer category in 1975. Triple-hops brewed for great pilsner taste! 4.2% ABV – 10 IBU's.
